General Discussion Questions on Cultural Conflict

How is cultural conflict portrayed in the story?

What are the main sources of this conflict—religion, tradition, language, class, gender roles?

How does the protagonist respond to the cultural conflict they face?

Do they assimilate, resist, rebel, or find a middle ground?

In what ways do generational differences intensify cultural conflict?

Are younger characters more open to change or more conflicted than older ones?

How does language serve as a barrier or bridge in the story?

Are there moments when language (or lack of understanding it) leads to misunderstanding or power imbalance?

How are gender roles impacted by cultural conflict?

Are expectations of masculinity or femininity challenged by new or dominant cultures?

Is there a clear "right" or "wrong" culture in the conflict, or is the narrative more nuanced?

How does the author portray each side of the cultural divide?
